ALL ABOUT THE WORK

When you've got big travel plans, securing enough work to fund your travel along the way can make or break your trip.

That's why we've partnered with New Zealand's Apata Group Ltd to offer guaranteed work in the kiwifruit season – meaning you'll have the funds to experience everything New Zealand has to offer once you've finished your placement.

As part of the opportunity, you will be required to commit to at least 35 hours of work per week for 12 weeks in one of the following packing operation role:

- GRADER ———— grading quality of fruit
- PACKER ————— packing fruit into bins, boxes, cartons, trays etc
- REPACKER ———— repacking fruit into other boxes and cartons,
 which might be required based on quality issues or
 opportunities
- STACKER stack the graded and packed fruit
- TRAY PREPPER —— putting trays together for the packers
- PICKER picking fruit
- WINTER PRUNING pruning (after the packing season)

FAQs

Who is eligible for the opportunity?

Everyone from school leavers to middle-aged professionals is welcome to join us for kiwi season! You must be at least 17 years old and reasonably physically fit.

Can I choose the job I want to do?

Within reason. ALA will take candidates' preferences into account when allocating jobs and shifts, but this may change depending on Apata's operational requirements.

What happens if either country locks down due to COVID?

In the event of either country locking down and/or travel not being possible due to COVID-19, ALA can offer candidates great alternative placements at desirable locations right across Australia. Apata Travel Agents book flexible flights and make arrangements to ensure that candidates will not lose money if bookings are cancelled.

When does the work placement begin?

You'll arrive in New Zealand in March 2022, with the season running from the middle of March to June.

Where are the roles located?

The packhouses are located in the Bay of Plenty, within 40km of Tauranga.

What does the job involve?

These manual labour roles involve grading, packing, repacking and stacking, with potential opportunities for forklift positions, depending on relevant industry experience and qualifications. Workers will be expected to work a minimum of 35 hours each week with hours spread over five days.

How much can I expect to earn?

Flights and accommodation will be deducted from wages upon commencement and candidates will receive an end of season bonus equivalent to negotiated flight reimbursement at the cessation of placement.

Do I need a visa?

You won't need a visa if you are an Australian citizen. If you are in Australia on a working rights visa, your recruiter can provide additional information on what process you may need to undertake.

What if I want to leave early?

If you want to finish up before the end of your placement you can leave at any time – you would, however, forfeit your flight reimbursement.

Who can I talk to with questions whilst I am there?

If you have any questions or concerns, you can come to your friendly ALA representative or your Apata supervisor. You can also enquire with the employment office which is present on every site.

Can I work and live with my friends?

We encourage people to apply with their friends, and will endeavour to place groups in accommodation together.

What if I want to work for longer than the twelve weeks?

Further opportunities are often available – you can talk to your ALA representative about taking up a different role within the industry in New Zealand or Australia. Apata has repacking and winter pruning jobs which may be suitable for candidates who are seeking ongoing employment opportunities.

Do I need to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to be able to take part?

Yes, all workers must have received two doses of a recognised COVID-19 vaccine.
